Volunteers are needed to assist with the set up and to ensure the mats remain accessible, and the participants are able to access the beach via the appropriate equipment.

You will receive onsite training, honorary membership to Surfers Paradise SLSC as well as a uniform, sunscreen, free meal and water during your shifts.
