Allied Health trainees will learn to support clinical staff across a wide range of professionals including Podiatry, Speech Pathology Dietetics, Occupational Therapy, Physiotherapy, and Rehabilitation.

Administrative

Our administration team support a wide range of clinical and non-clinical services across the GCHHS. Opportunities include ward reception, general reception, IT, human resources, finance, communications, business administration, mailroom, switchboard phone rooms and more.

Dental

Working as part of the dental team, trainee dental assistants observe and learn to provide efficient, high quality dental assistance to eligible patients and instrument reprocessing services within Oral Health facilities across the GCHHS.

Nursing

The Trainee Assistant in nursing will learn to be responsible for assisting and supporting the Nurse Unit Manager, registered nurses, enrolled nurses and the clinical team in the provision of quality patient care. The role works under the direction and supervision of the registered nurse to plan workload and prioritise activities.

Operating Theatre Assistant

As an Operating Theatre Assistant Trainee, you'll gain hands-on experience in a high-stakes medical environment. Under the guidance of experienced staff, you'll prepare the operating theatre, ensure instruments are sterilized, support the surgical team during procedures, maintain a sterile environment, and assist with patient care pre- and post-operation.

Important: Students must be up to date with childhood vaccinations and be available on both the recruitment day (to be confirmed) and for commencement day (to be confirmed). It is important to note that while you are completing the traineeship under school based arrangements that you will be required you to work 1 day a week (minimum 7.5 hours) during the school term and 2-3 days a week over the school holiday blocks to ensure you have completed the minimum 375 hours as outlined on the QTIS website to be eligible for completion of the traineeship within 12 months from your start date.
