Motivated candidates applying for this position **MUST** meet the following expectations and eligibility:

- Display a **genuine motivation** to embark on a **career** pathway in the Construction Industry upon completion of your secondary education.
- Enrolled in **Year 12 in 2024**.
- **ATAR and Non-ATAR** students are welcome to apply.
- Australian Citizen or Permanent Resident or NZ Passport holder lived in Australia for **6 months or more**.
- **Not currently enrolled** in another apprenticeship or traineeship.
- Must have a **WHITE CARD**.
- **Certificate I** in Construction **preferred**.
- Must have their **manual license** and **vehicle**.
- Committed to completing **work placement** prior to final candidate selection.
- Successful School Based Apprentices must commit and be prepared to work **1 day per school week (minimum 7.5 hours) and 2-3 days per week over the school holidays, without** compromising your school commitments.
- It is expected that successful **apprentices prioritise their School Based Apprenticeship** over other casual employment on school holidays.
- Apprentices' complete compulsory **theory in their own time**, outside of work.
- If you are a successful School Based Candidate, you and your parent/guardian **MUST** attend a Compulsory **OSMAC Sign Up Meeting**.
