# Pacific Motorway (M1) Varsity Lakes to Tugun upgrade Service relocations – Sarawak Avenue, Palm Beach

## About the work

Service relocation works are continuing adjacent to Currumbin Creek as part of early works for the M1 Varsity Lakes to Tugun (VL2T) upgrade.

These works to relocate Gold Coast Water services, including sewer, recycled water and drinking water, will allow for motorway widening to occur as part of mainline construction for Package C Palm Beach to Tugun.

Work is planned to start overnight from **6pm Monday 9 November** and will continue for about one month with traffic management in place.

*It is important to note that wet weather, contractor and site conditions may impact this work schedule.*

## Expected impacts

Sarawak Avenue westbound between the Salk Oval carpark and the M1 overpass will be reduced to one lane for the duration of this work – refer to map overleaf.

Electronic signage will be installed to advise motorists of the upcoming works.

Access to the western Salk Oval carpark and dedicated bike lane on Sarawak Avenue will be closed.

Pedestrian and cycling access to Currumbin Creek, sports clubs, pedestrian bridge and sports grounds will remain open, with directional signage in place.

The bus stop on Sarawak Avenue will remain open during this period.

Speed restrictions will be in place – expect minor delays and allow extra travel time.

Motorists and residents can expect ongoing work and localised impacts in this area until end of 2023 as part of construction for Package C.

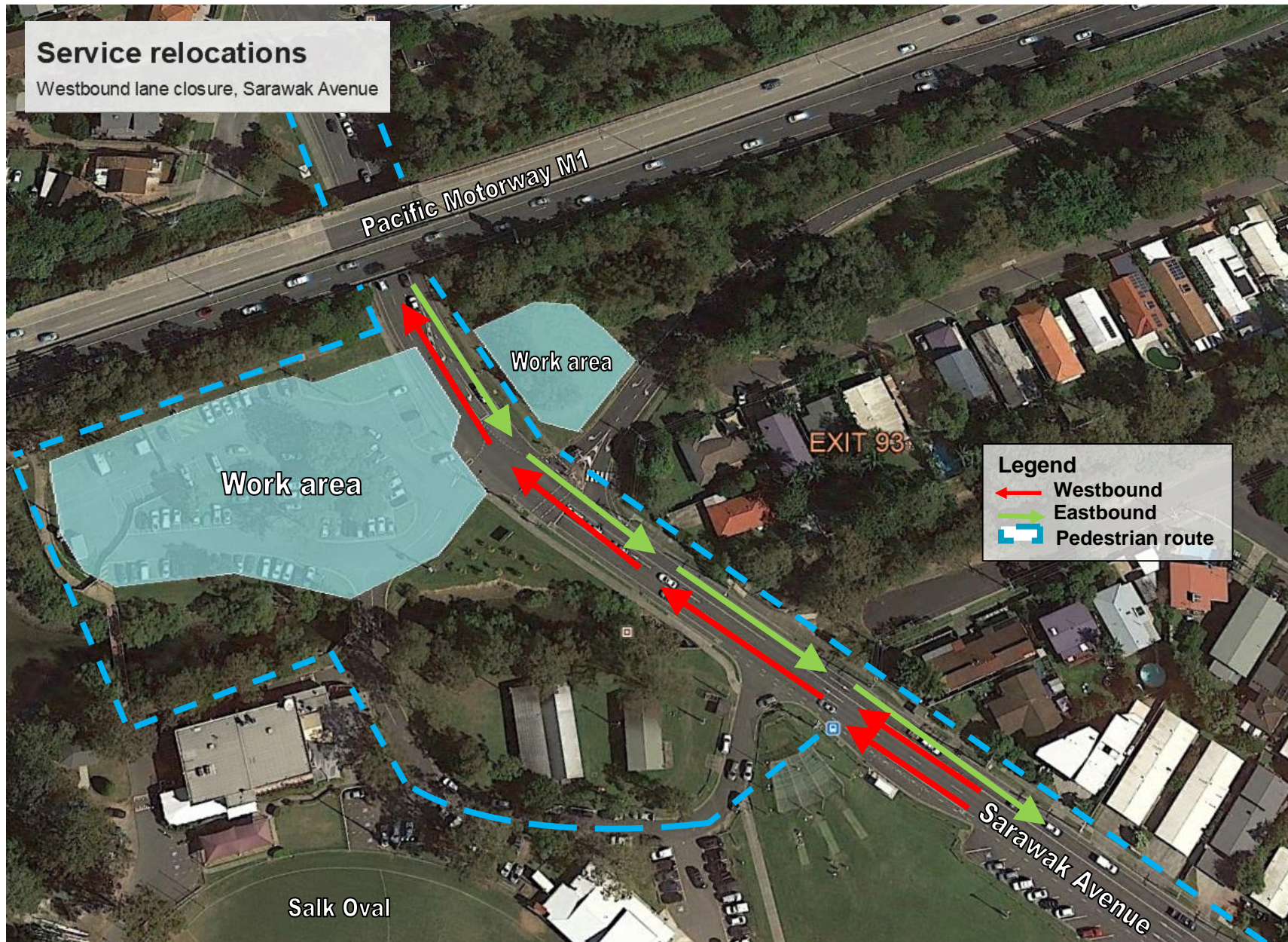
