

## **Notification of works**

## Thrower Drive Bridge, Currumbin – maintenance works (Stage 2)

Stage 1 rehabilitation works were completed on the Thrower Drive Bridge over Currumbin Creek ahead of the Gold Coast 2018 Commonwealth Games. Stage 2 maintenance works are now underway. The bridge will remain open at all times with some minor temporary restrictions for waterway users only. Road and pedestrian traffic will not be affected.

Commencing: April 2019

Completion: June 2019 (weather permitting)
Working hours: Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm

Stage 2 works include installation of the structural encasements ("jackets") on the remaining 12 concrete piles. All works will take place below the bridge deck and underwater. Barges and scaffolding will be used for safe access.

Every effort will be made to minimise disruptions. However, local residents may notice construction noise at times and increased activity in proximity of the bridge. There will be no impacts to motorists and pedestrians on the bridge. Access will be maintained for waterway users, however there will be temporary speed restrictions at times during construction.

## Project benefits include:
