1 SAFETY

6 SOCIALISING

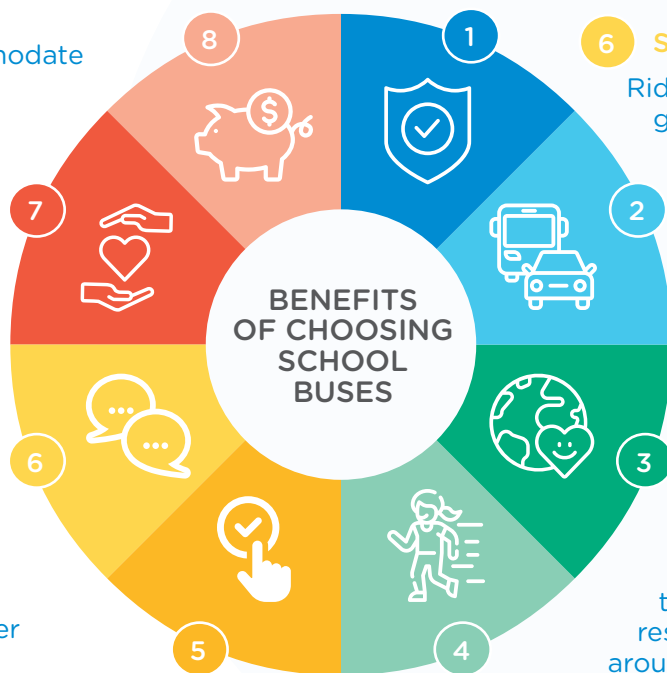
Riding the school bus is a great way for children to socialise and make new friends especially if they are new to the school or area.
