SCU STAR Early Entry

SCU STAR Early Entry enables Year 12 students who attend an SCU partner high school to gain early admission to the University on the basis of their school Principal's recommendation.

What are the benefits of Early Entry?

Successful SCU STAR Early Entry applicants will receive their offer to Southern Cross University ahead of the crowd. You won't need to wait to find out your Year 12 results before you start making plans for university. SCU will notify Queensland students in mid-October and NSW students in mid-November of the outcome of their application. You can get in ahead of everyone else to organise all the things you need to make your transition to university as smooth as possible.

There are no fees associated with your SCU STAR Early Entry registration.

Can I apply for all SCU courses through STAR?

Most SCU undergraduate courses are available through STAR. There are a few exceptions. Courses not on offer through STAR in 2017 are the Bachelor of Midwifery and our Education degrees. Applications for these courses can be made via UAC or QTAC.

Who is eligible to apply SCU STAR Early Entry?

How do I apply?

Step 1

Visit scu.edu.au/star to download your STAR Student Advice Guide. The guide outlines the Year 12 subject areas and achievement levels you will need to be recommended for your chosen course.

Step 2

Identify your SCU course options by visiting scu.edu.au/courses

Step 3

STAR registrations open 20 July – go to the course of your choice at scu.edu.au/courses, click on the STAR Entry button on the course information page or go to the STAR website at scu.edu.au/star and click on the registration link.

Make sure you have your Year 12 number handy. Complete your SCU STAR Early Entry registration nominating your first and second course preferences.

Step 4

In October/November – successful applicants will receive an offer into the course preference their Principal has recommended. Your offer letter will be sent to you at the email address you supplied when you registered. Just click on the link to accept your offer and enrol in your course.

SCU STAR Early Entry offers are valid for students commencing their study in 2017.
