Officials Course Level O

The next Level 0 Officials course is at Kirra on the 6 Sept. The level 0 course allows you to officiate at junior carnivals, without decision-making authority. Level 1 Officials can make decisions and can officiate at junior and senior carnivals. For Carnivals along with water safety, Kirra nippers are required to provide one official for every 10 competitors for our kids to be eligible to compete at carnivals.

Get Started Vouchers

The Get Started Vouchers program provides assistance for those who need it most (Qld Residents Only). Get Started Vouchers assists children and young people who can least afford, or may otherwise benefit from, joining a sport or active recreation club. Eligible children and young people are presented with a voucher that provides up to \$150 to help with the costs for membership and participation fees. Ways to Pay 2017/18 Membership

- Pay Online save all the paperwork - (portal.sls.com)

RENEWING - Login to your Members Portal account, select the Lifesaving Online tab and select Renew next to the organisation you want to renew

ONLINE PAYMENTS - when you submit your renewal for an individual or family group you will be prompted to make an online payment. To access the online payment screen at any time login to the Portal, select the Lifesaving Online tab and then selected Online Payments from the sub menu

FAMILY GROUPS - a family member over 18 years can create a Family Group that will enable them to manage and renew all family members at once and eliminate the need to have individual Portal accounts for each family member. To access Family Groups in the Portal select the Lifesaving Online tab and select My Family from the sub-menu.
