Cycling Australia Masters Road National Championships

Sunday 29 October 2017

On Sunday 29 October, cyclists will compete in the Masters Road National Championships.

The closed-road race is an 18.7 km loop from the Currumbin Beachfront to Elanora and out through Currumbin Valley.

This is the same route that will be used during the official Gold Coast 2018 Commonwealth Games (GC2018).

Presented by Cycling Queensland on behalf of Cycling Australia, the Championships will act as an operational trial to test the course and implement key components ahead of GC2018.

The Gold Coast 2018 Commonwealth Games Corporation, City of Gold Coast and other Games partners are engaging extensively with southern Gold Coast residents and businesses to ensure they have all the information required to plan for this event.

During the 2017 National Masters Championship event, Currumbin, Currumbin Waters and Elanora will experience changes to traffic.

To ensure safety and the smooth running of this competition there will be temporary changes to traffic, parking, public transport and access to some areas. If you have to travel during this time, please be aware that the roads will be busier than usual. Plan ahead and leave plenty of time for your journey. Pedestrian access will be maintained along the race route, so walking and cycling may be better options to access local areas.

EMERGENCY SERVICES

Emergency services will have access to all areas at all times.

- Please call 000 in case of an emergency.

PARKING CHANGES

During the event, there will be changes to on-street parking along the race route and in nearby areas.

- Vehicles should not be parked on the course (shown in blue on the map) from 3am to 6pm on Sunday 29 October 2017.
- Parking restrictions in other streets will be sign posted in advance of the event.
- Cars parked on the course may be towed at owners expense.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT CHANGES

There will be a number of changes to bus services.

- All bus routes in the area will be diverted.
- Route 763 and 766 services will not operate due to road closures.
- Most bus stops in Currumbin, Currumbin Waters and Elanora will be closed.

TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT

Police, traffic controllers and volunteer marshals will be located on the course.

If possible, we suggest you make alternative travel arrangements to avoid delays and help keep traffic to a minimum.

- Please be patient and follow the directions given.
- Local residents will be able to enter and exit at limited times under the direction of police and traffic controllers (see residential access).

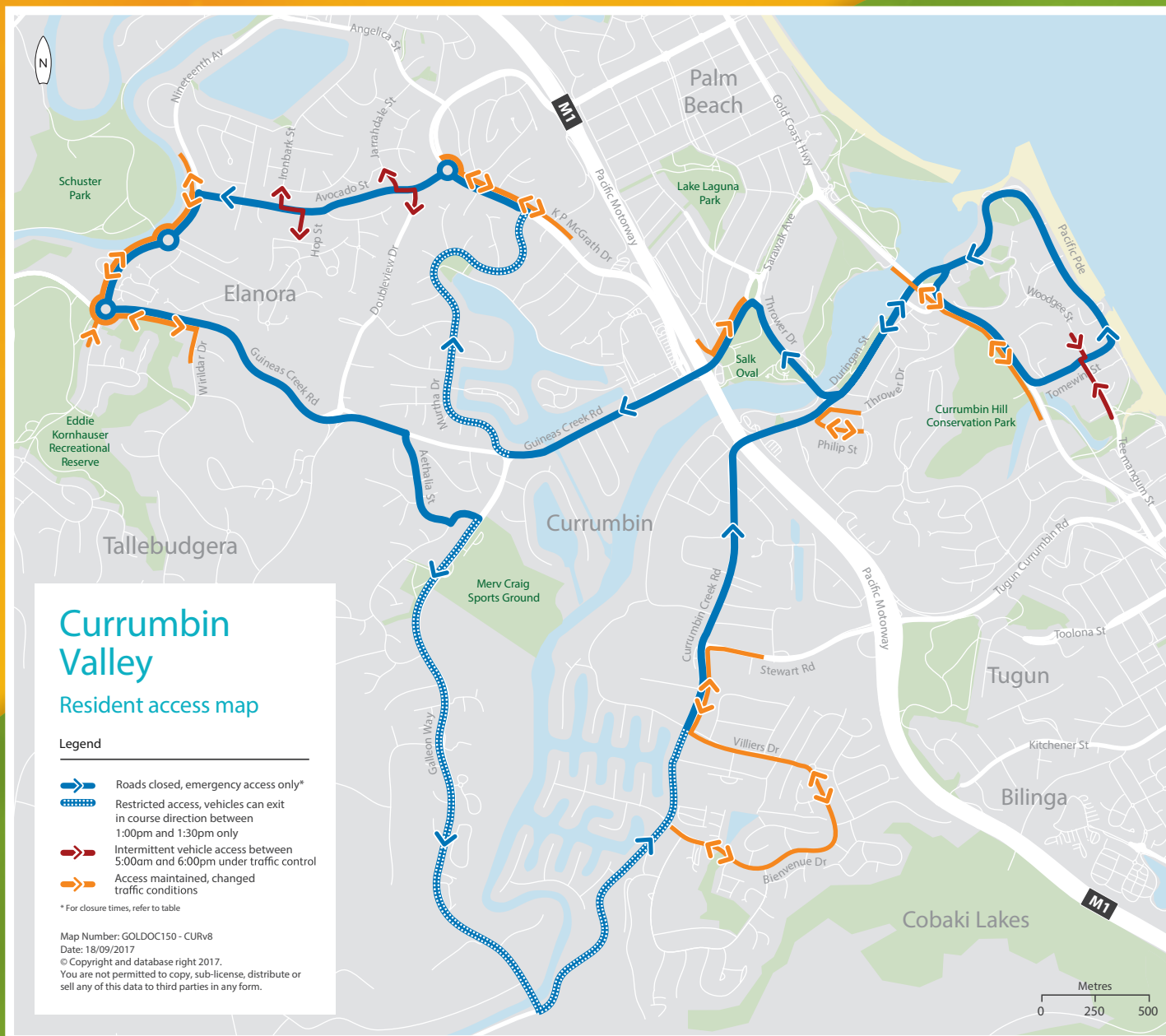
