Business as usual during week 9 and 10

Information from Get Set for the Games and the Department of Transport and Main Roads confirms very minor impacts around specific venues in Broadbeach and Carrara during Weeks 9 and 10 of Term 1.

These very few road closures are not expected to lead to major delays, however any staff residing in or driving through these areas are encouraged to look at getsetforthegames.com and review their journey.

What's the impact in Brisbane?

Two events will be held in Brisbane during the games; Shooting at the Belmont Shooting Centre and Cycling at the Anna Meares Velodrome.

During this period some areas within Chandler and Belmont will get busier than usual in the lead up to, and throughout, GC2018 including:

- Temporary road and lane closures
- · Predicted travel disruptions
- Predicted hotspots and impacts
- Changes to parking and loading zones
- Bus stop and timetable changes, and
- Local traffic management.



The 4Rs - Reduce, Re-time, Re-route, Re-mode

During the Games we all have a part to play in helping ease congestion on our roads. Our goal is to reduce demand for particular travel modes and routes and spread our trips across the transport network. For example:

Reduce Non-essential travel for professional development, excursions and rehearsals.

- Example: Schedule travel and meetings for week 1-8.
- Strategy: Email stakeholders and lock in calendar.
 Keebra SHS & Elanora SHS- Week 10 is exam block to reduce travel.
 Coombabah SS No excursions/professional development during Week 9 and 10.

Retime Your work journey earlier.

- Example: Arrive at 7am instead of 8am to complete planning instead of after school or night time.
- Strategy: Conversation and email with line Manager and ensure alarms and office available.

Robina SHS - Due to Flexible Student Free Day on Monday 16th April, the Local Consultative Committee confirmed no teaching or non-teaching staff would be on-site that day.

Re-route All staff have a plan B and plan C to get to school.

- Example: travel the back way through Nerang to Pacific Pines-Oxenford SS.
- Strategy: Google maps, live traffic check before departure.

Re-mode carpooling be an option. Cycling/Bus to wok be supported. Public transport.

- Example: carpool team from Currumbin to Palm Beach to Worongary State School.
- Strategy: Departments share staff suburbs with list paper/contact to organise carpool.
