

Residential access

Exit routes are an option for local residents between the hours of **12.30am – 6.30am on Thursday 5 April and Saturday 7 April 2018.**

If using the roads during the designated exiting time period, please be aware that you are driving in closed road conditions. To ensure the safety of workers installing infrastructure on the road, please drive under 40 km/hr, use your hazard lights, and follow the direction that the changed traffic conditions map outlines.

Please be careful and follow any direction given by staff and traffic controllers. No vehicles can access affected roads at any stage throughout competition days other than residents within local access area.

How will travel be affected?

To ensure safety and the smooth running of this competition there will be temporary changes to traffic, parking, public transport and access to some areas. If you have to travel during this time, please be aware that the roads will be busier than usual. Plan ahead and leave plenty of time for your journey. Pedestrian access will be maintained along the competition route, so walking and cycling may be better options to access local areas.

EMERGENCY SERVICES

Emergency services will have access to all areas at all times:

- Please call 000 in case of an emergency.

TRAVEL TIPS

- Avoid coastal roads and use western roads.
- If you need to travel during road closure hours, park west of affected roads.

PARKING CHANGES

During the event, there will be changes to on-street parking along the race route and in nearby areas:

- Vehicles should not be parked on any affected roads shown within the road closure area in red shaded area on the map from 12.30am to 6pm on 5 April and 7 April 2018.
- Parking restrictions will be sign posted in advance of the event.
- Towing will commence from 12.30am on Thursday 5 April and Saturday 7 April. For towing enquires, please call Policelink on 131 444.

TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT

Police, traffic controllers, security guards and volunteer marshals will be located on the course. If possible, we suggest you make alternative travel arrangements to avoid delays and help keep traffic to a minimum:

- Please be patient and follow the directions given.
- Only local residents will be able to exit affected roads during exit periods.
- No access will be permitted at all times except for the yellow shaded areas on the map.

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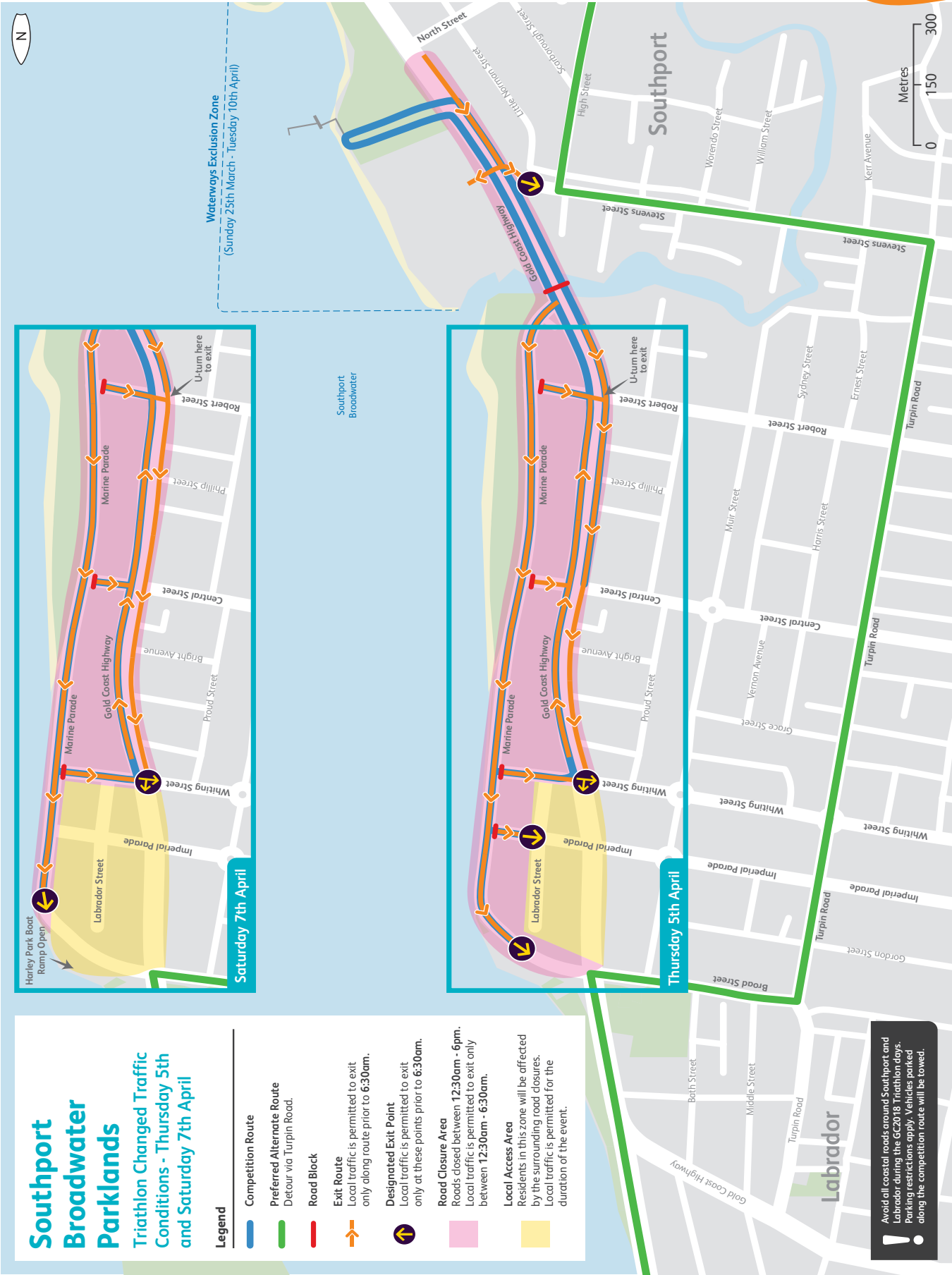
