

Yatala Park 'n' Ride

The Gold Coast 2018 Commonwealth Games (GC2018) are coming from 4-15 April.

This once in a lifetime opportunity will see 11 days of world class competition on our doorstep. To get set for this exciting event, Yatala Park 'n' Ride will be established for exclusive use by GC2018 ticketed spectators attending competition at Carrara Stadium.

From **mid February to early April 2018**, 1/57 Burnside Road will be transformed into a temporary GC2018 transport facility.

What's happening?

Temporary items will be installed including barriers, amenities, a generator, lighting tower and site cabins.

Works will take place Monday to Friday between 6.30am - 5.30pm, and Saturday between 6.30am - 5pm, subject to weather and site conditions

Every effort will be made to minimise impacts on local residents and businesses, however temporary impacts such as noise and dust may be experienced during pre and post-Games works.

Post-Games works

Will take place after the Games to remove temporary items, and restore the site to pre-Games conditions.

Yatala Park 'n' Ride will see 1700 vehicles parking for each competition session. With up to two session changes each day, the local area will be much busier with more people, more traffic and heightened security measures during Games time.
