The plan started in Term 4 2017, and its main objectives are to educate, reduce and integrate environmentally sustainable outcomes for PBC.

We have been achieving some fantastic goals with implementing and driving change within the school and some of these are:

- Established a Sustainability Committee that meets every 2 weeks throughout school term;
