If you are intending on going to University next year or deferring then you must complete a QTAC application. Please find attached information from the Queensland Tertiary Admissions Centre (QTAC). This will help you with your QTAC applications for University next year. Please note than in addition to this information you should have also received a QTAC guide. The guide has all the information you need to choose courses for next year. Application fee is \$43.

Aptitude for Engineering Assessment (AEA): applications now open The aptitude for engineering assessment (AEA) offers Year 12 students an admissions pathway into engineering at Griffith University.

The exam is a two-and-a-half hour multiple choice test that assesses the candidate's aptitude to think scientifically, solve quantitative problems, critically analyse information and display interpersonal understanding.



Students who successfully pass the exam will receive admission directly into the Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) or Bachelor of Engineering Technology in Electronic and Computer Engineering at Griffith University.
