Overview	The scholarship aims to assist high achieving and highly motivated local students who have been offered a place at an Australian TAFE institute and are experiencing financial and/or social challenges.
Eligible course / level of study	<ul> <li>Eligible courses include:</li> <li>Full-time or competency based completion (Apprenticeships)</li> <li>Certificate I, II, III or IV</li> <li>Diploma, Advanced Diploma or Associate Degree</li> <li>Course must be of at least 10 weeks' duration for full-time study or the part time equivalent</li> <li>Courses ineligible for this scholarship include VETiS, Foundation level training and short courses</li> </ul>
Study area	All
Scholarship type	Need based, Merit based
Duration	One year initially – but may be awarded for up to two years or for the duration of the successful recipient's course up to a maximum of two years (whichever is the lesser) for each successful recipient
Intention of Scholarship	Study related expenses including accommodation and course costs, study related materials/equipment, text books, tutoring and/or educational related travel (within Australia)
Award Value	\$5,000 (per annum) per student
Eligibility	To be eligible the student must meet the following criteria:  must be an Australian citizen or permanent resident  must reside in, or have attended a secondary school in, postcode 4221,4223, 4224, 4225, 2485 or 2486  should be able to demonstrate the challenging circumstances (financial &/or social) hindering the student's ability to undertake further study  should be academically motivated  should be able to demonstrate community involvement.  TAFE Scholarship Specific Qualification criteria:  must be aged 16 – 25 (as at 30 January 2019) – students under the age of 18 years will require parental / guardian consent to accept this scholarship  must have left secondary school — having completed Year 10 as a minimum  must have been offered a place to study at an approved Australian TAFE institute campus, in an approved Australian course in 2019  Applicants can be studying on campus and/or off campus (including on-line)  Applicants can be studying on a full-time or part-time basis
Nationality	Australian citizen or permanent resident
Application dates	OPEN: 3 December 2018 CLOSE: 29 January 2019
How to apply	Applications are invited from 3 December 2018 and can only be submitted online. Please visit <b>bendigobank.com.au/scholarships</b> for more information from this date.
Criteria	Scholarships will be awarded on the recommendation of a selection committee and will be based on how an applicant addresses the following criteria:  Academic achievement  Financial and/or social challenges  Evidence of leadership and citizenship within their communities
