VISION: Tugun – Now & Then

Concept brief

An overview of the concept design and it's intended purpose.

The entrant is to provide a sketch design of the artist's representation of Tugun's historic significance to the southern gateway of the Gold Coast, it's people, it's natural environment and the current Tugun we enjoy today.



The mural must lend itself to 'social media worthiness' and potentially incorporate the ability for a 'selfie' background location.

Tugun icons for possible representation include fig tree, beach, village, surf club, castle (old), airport.

Supplies

Information on the supplies which will be provided to the winning artist of the competition.

The competition includes an allocation of up to \$1,000 for materials to produce the mural as well as anti graffiti protection, transportation of the mural (if required) and installation costs. The board used for the design must be Weathertex.

Supplies which can be claimed under the allocation include the artist's board, paint and paint brushes/drawing tools.

Concept design

Information on the requirements of the design and finished product. The mural must not exceed 3000mm (w) x 1200mm (h). The mural will hang 1000mm off the ground.

The design must be submitted in the full colour representation of the conceptual design.

The design must not be offensive or represent any views regarding a political party, religious beliefs or associated matters.



Judging

Information on judging and required attendance for the announcement of finalists and winners.

Entrants will be judged on merit, creativity and brief conditions.

3 finalists will progress to the final judging round.

There will be 1 winner only, as determined by a panel of members of the community including Tugun **Community Bank**® Branch directors and employees, key stakeholders and a local artist.

All entrants must attend the Creative Life Storyfest event on 30 March 2019 at Tugun Park for the announcement of the finalists.

The finalists must attend the Youth Week event on 6 April 2019 at Tugun Skate Park for the announcement of the winner.

Prize

Prize information.

The winner will receive \$2,000 which will be deposited into either an existing Bendigo Bank account or an account must be opened with Tugun **Community Bank**® Branch.

Submission

How to submit the design.

The concept design must be submitted using sketching paper with no creases or folds. The registration form must be completed including a description or background of the design as well as the type of materials and mediums that will be used and the length of time for the project to be completed.
